Project glossary

Aboriginal people The first people to live in Australia.
background The part of a scene that appears furthest away to the viewer.
composition The arrangement of the objects in a picture.
cool colour A colour that can make us feel cool, calm or sad, such as blue or green, and can make the object seem further away.
foreground The part of a scene that appears closest to the viewer.
ochre Coloured earth that can be used to make dyes and paints.
primary colour A colour that cannot be made by mixing other colours. The primary colours are red, yellow and blue.
recede To appear to move further away into the distance, or to become less clear.
secondary colour A colour that is made by mixing equal amounts of two primary colours. The

secondary colours are green, orange and purple.

tertiary colour

A colour made by mixing equal amounts of a primary and secondary colour. Example tertiary colours include red-purple and blue-green.

warm colour

A colour that evokes a feeling of warmth, happiness and energy, such as red or yellow, and can make the object seem closer to the viewer.
